Plesovschih Olga was born in 1934 in Staseni in a family of 5 children. In 1949 her family was deported to Siberia, Russia for being suspected enemies of Soviet party. Because of the harsh conditions of living and weather conditions in Siberia her father and one of her sister died. The family allowed to return to Moldova ten years later.

Olga married and had two sons. Her husband died when they were both young. Olga's oldest son was badly burned in an accident in 2000 and died. Her youngest son suffers from alcoholism. Olga hopes her son can recover from this disease.

Olga worked as accountant at the post office in Straseni for many years. In 1992 she retired. She receives a monthly pension 32 Euros. Now she lives alone in her house. During the winter months she heats only one room to save money and heating fuel.

Olga is very ill and suffers from osteoporosis. She needs a peroidic treatment for this which costs 37 Euros, which she can not afford.

Olga has been attending Sunrise Day Center for the Elderly since 2004 and she is grateful for the services she receives.
